HYUNDAI MOTOR PROVIDES OFFICIAL PROTOCOL VEHICLES FOR THE FIRST KOREA-CENTRAL ASIA SUMMIT 2026

- Hyundai Motor will supply 33 Genesis G90 and G80 sedans as official protocol vehicles during the First Korea–Central Asia Summit 2026
- The summit will bring together leaders from Korea and five Central Asian nations, including Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan

SEOUL, July 27, 2026 — Hyundai Motor Company announced today that it will provide official protocol vehicles to heads of state and delegations attending the First Korea-Central Asia Summit 2026, scheduled for September 16, 2026.

The company signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the vehicle cooperation with the Preparatory Office for the Korea-Central Asia Summit at the Seo-hee Hall of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Seoul.

The ceremony was attended by Deputy Foreign Minister for Political Affairs Chung Eui-hae and Dong Jo Kim, Senior Vice President and Head of Global Policy Office at Hyundai Motor Group, along with key government and company officials.
